

C. difficile surveillance

Quarterly report

April 2018 - June 2018

Key points

- CDI reports for hospital inpatients aged 65 years and over decreased by 7% (from 67 to 62 episodes) during April June 2018 compared to January March 2018.
- CDI rate per 1,000 bed days decreased by 1% April June 2018 compared to January March 2018.
- CDI reports for community patients aged 65 years and over increased by 67% (from 30 to 50 episodes) during April June 2018 compared to January March 2018.
- Total CDI reports, for hospital inpatients and community patients combined, aged two years and over, increased by 20% during April - June 2018 compared to January - March 2018 (from 119 to 143 episodes).
- CDI reports for hospital inpatients aged 65 years and over increased by 11% between the 2016/17 and 2017/18 financial years.
- During April June 2018 the most prevalent ribotypes for CDI inpatients are 002 (24%), 078 (9%), 014 (7%) and 005 (5%), 020 (5%) and 106 (5%) (Table 1) and in the community are 002 (14%), 078 (14%), 011 (7%), 014 (7%), 015 (7%) and 023 (7%) (Table 2).




Figure 1: Total CDI episodes, <u>inpatient and community</u>, in Northern Ireland, by quarter (patients ≥ 65 years), between 2005 and 2018




Figure 2a: Total CDI <u>inpatient</u> episodes in Northern Ireland, by quarter (patients ≥ 65 years), between 2005 and 2018




Figure 2b: Total CDI <u>inpatient</u> episodes in Northern Ireland, by quarter (patients ≥ 65 years), between 2008 and 2018

Statistical process control (SPC) charts

SPC charts allow a distinction to be made between natural variation and 'special cause variation',
where something unusual may be occurring. Trends in CDI rates since July 2005 are shown for
each HSCT in appendix B.




Figure 3: Statistical process control chart for quarterly *C. difficile* rates among <u>inpatients</u> in Northern Ireland aged 65 years and over (for HSCT level, see appendix B)




Figure 4: Quarterly rates of *C. difficile* among <u>inpatients aged 65 years and over</u>, by HSCT, January 2017 – June 2018, compared with annual Northern Ireland and HSCT rates for 2017




Figure 5: *C. difficile* rates during April - June 2018 - <u>Inpatients aged 65 years and over</u>, by hospital, including HSCT rates and average rate for Northern Ireland (see appendix A, Table 4)




Figure 6: *C. difficile* rates during April - June 2018 - <u>Inpatients aged two years and over</u>, by hospital, including HSCT rates and average rate for Northern Ireland (see appendix A, Table 5)








Trends in C. difficile rates in inpatients aged 65 years and over, by HSCT and quarter, 2005 - 2018
